RESPONSE OPTIONS: two- or three- item positive response criterion (not specified)

- 2. Have people annoyed you by criticizing your drinking?
- 3. Have you ever felt bad or guilty about your drinking?
- 4. Have you ever had a drink first thing in the morning to steady your nerves or to get rid of a hang-over (eye-opener)?
