SURVEY ITEMS: 34 items

Psychological cyber aggression: Cronbach's  $\alpha$ = .75 Sexual cyber aggression: Cronbach's  $\alpha$ = .71 Stalking cyber aggression: Cronbach's  $\alpha$ = .85

### Perpetration:

Psychological cyber aggression: Cronbach's  $\alpha$ = .74

If these things did not happen in the past six months, but did happen before, please circle 7.
