POPULATION: Women, men, HIV-positive, patients

RESPONSE OPTIONS: Today, yesterday, earlier this week, last week, less than a month ago, more than a month ago, I have never missed

SCORING: Anything other than "never" = nonadherent

SURVEY ITEMS: "When was the last time that you missed taking your antiretroviral pills?"

RELIABILITY INFORMATION: No reliability information reported.

VALIDITY INFORMATION: Criterion-related validity assessed via comparison with viral load.
