1.	Is the person someone you depend on for personal care (like dressing, bathing, or using the toilet?)

Setting and Sample

A detailed description of the setting and sample are reported elsewhere (Oschwald et al., 2009). Participants who self-identified as experiencing a disability consistent with the Americans With Disabilities Act (1990; that is, a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities) were recruited from various community agencies and organizations in southeast Texas, southwest Washington, and Oregon. The characteristics of the women who completed the SSP at T1 and T2 were not significantly different. In general, participants were middleaged (mean age = 50.75, SD = 12.87) White (57%) or African American (31%) women who lived alone (67.9%). Only 32% were married or partnered. Their average annual household income was US\$11,813, despite the fact that 70% reported attending some college. Most women (69%) reported experiencing more than one disability, 54% reported using one or more assistive devices, and 48% used personal assistance.
