RESPONSE OPTIONS: Number of missed doses in the past 3 days.

SCORING: Categorized into two groups: those with any missed doses and those with no missed doses

SURVEY ITEMS: Not reported

RELIABILITY INFORMATION: No reliability information was reported.

VALIDITY INFORMATION: Criterion-related validity was assessed via comparison with viral suppression (sensitivity analysis).
