SURVEY ITEMS: 6 factors (25 items) Emotional respect Abusiveness Economic stress Instability Sexual adequacy Emotional flexibility

RELIABILITY INFORMATION: Cronbach's α= .91

- WAI and Child Abuse Inventory (CAP)
- WAI and self-reported physical abuse
- WAI and self-reported emotional abuse

Emotional respect Abusiveness Economic stress Instability Sexual adequacy Emotional flexibility

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
