**RESPONSE OPTIONS:** 0 (did not occur) to 7 (occurred more than 20 times in the past year)

## **SURVEY ITEMS:**

- 1. The person called me pejorative names that have to do with my LGBTQ status
- 2. The person told me I deserve what I get because of my sexual orientation or gender identity
- 3. The person threatened to tell my employer, family, or others about my sexual orientation or gender identity
- 4. The person used my sexual orientation or gender identity against me
- 5. The person prevented me from seeking support within the LGBTQ community
- 6. The person forced me to show physical or sexual affection in public, even though I didn't want to
- 7. The person questioned whether my sexual orientation or gender identity was "real"

**RELIABILITY INFORMATION:** Cronbach's  $\alpha = .80$ 

VALIDITY INFORMATION: Exploratory Factor Analysis was conducted
